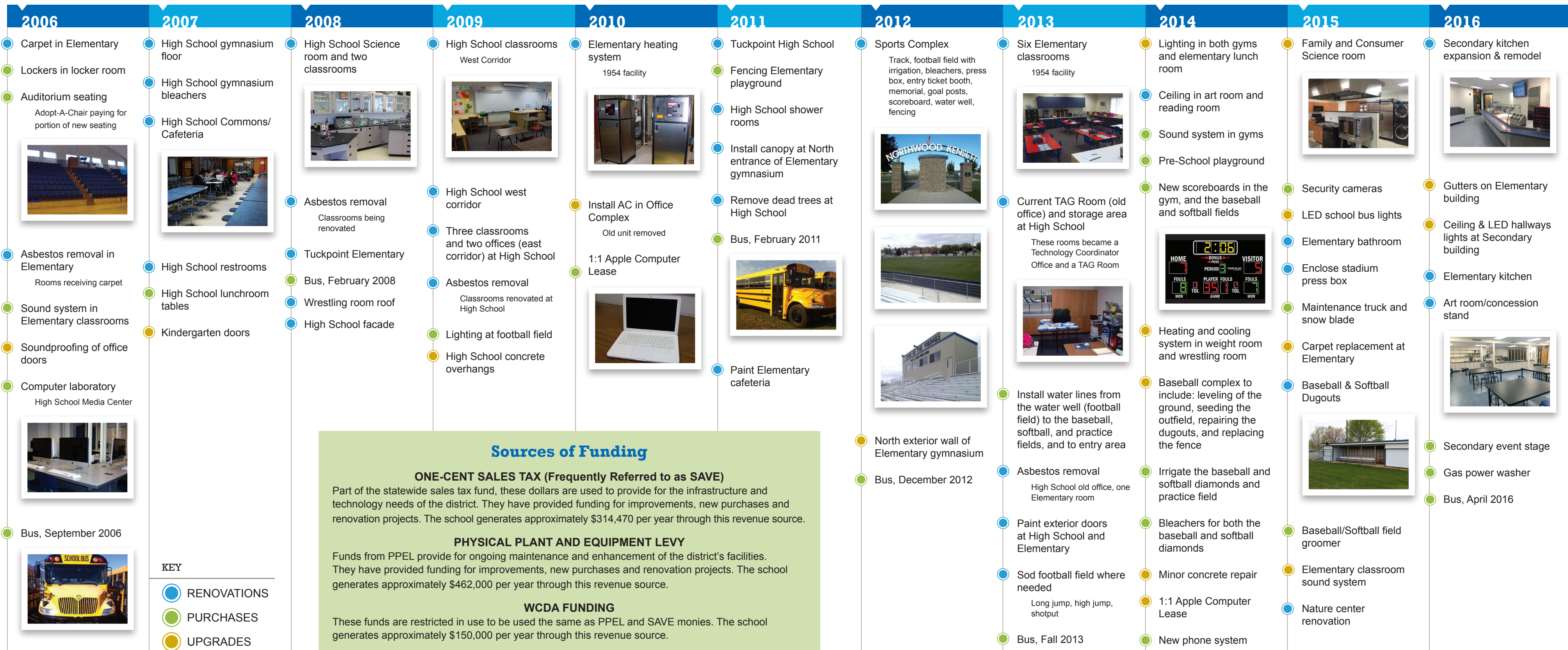


Northwood-Kensett COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

Sources of Funding

ONE-CENT SALES TAX (Frequently Referred to as SAVE)

Part of the statewide sales tax fund, these dollars are used to provide for the infrastructure and technology needs of the district. They have provided funding for improvements, new purchases and renovation projects. The school generates approximately \$314,470 per year through this revenue source.

PHYSICAL PLANT AND EQUIPMENT LEVY

Funds from PPEL provide for ongoing maintenance and enhancement of the district's facilities. They have provided funding for improvements, new purchases and renovation projects. The school generates approximately \$462,000 per year through this revenue source.

WCDA FUNDING

These funds are restricted in use to be used the same as PPEL and SAVE monies. The school generates approximately \$150,000 per year through this revenue source.
